This report compares the performance of examinees from your medical school with the performance of examinees from U.S. and Canadian Medical Schools taking Step 1 of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) for the first time during 2005. The performance of first-time examinees who failed Step 1 in 2005 but repeated the examination later in the year is also summarized above. The minimum passing score for the 2005 Step 1 administrations was 182.

Accompanying this table are two graphs: one that shows the distribution of scores (for your students and for the national first-taker group), and one that provides information regarding the performance of first-time examinees from your school for various disciplines and organ systems. Please note that the graphs are only provided if at least 20 first-time examinees from your school took Step 1 in 2005.

Step 1 test items are deliberately designed to be integrative; most items contribute to the calculation of subscores in more than one discipline. Consequently, caution should be used in attributing mean differences in student performance to individual courses at your school.
