This report compares the performance of examinees from your medical school with the performance of examinees from U.S. and Canadian Medical Schools taking Step 2 of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) for the first time in the 2001-2002 academic year. The performance of first-time examinees who failed Step 2 in the academic year but repeated the examination later in the year is also summarized above. The minimum passing score was 174.

There is a graph that provides information regarding the performance of first-time examinees from your school for various content categories. Please note that the graph is only provided if at least 20 first-time examinees from your school took Step 2 in academic year 2001-2002.

Step 2 test items are deliberately designed to be integrative: many items contribute to the calculation of scores in more than one discipline. Consequently, caution should be used in attributing mean differences in student performance to individual clerkships at your school.
